GENERAL NOTICES

BUS ZONE

The area along the green fence outside the Office is officially a bus zone from 8-9:30am and 2:30-4pm each school day. Please refrain from parking or stopping there at these times.

DISABLED PARKING

We have a few disabled parking spaces – one at the bottom of the nose-to-kerb parks and some at the Grace Centre. These spots are used legitimately on an ongoing basis, so we ask that you please do not park there and leave them for the disabled.

PICKING UP THE KIDS

Please note that the Primary children are not permitted to cross the road unless accompanied by an adult. We recommend parents park on the school side of the road when possible and come to the gates/fence to collect children.

SUPERVISION OF STUDENTS

Supervision is available from 8:15am each school morning. Students arriving between 8:15 and 8:30am are to go directly to the Library. At 8:30am, playground supervision commences.

NOTE: No child can be on the premises prior to 8:15am. Also, students need to be collected by 3:30pm when teacher supervision finishes. Trindy children need to be collected from the classroom by 3:15pm.

LATE STUDENTS

All students arriving late must be signed in at the Office by a parent (seniors included) or produce a signed note from a parent. This will ensure they do not incur an unexplained absence on their permanent record.
